5 Site Assessments AL /ALL	AL has carried out a "standardised" assessment of all sites using nationally agreed criteria. It is a rag rated system which determines if sites meet criteria on a 3 point scale:  • Fully, or without intervention/acceptable impact • Mitigation required to meet criteria, impact may be mitigated;/requires further information • Unlikely to meet criteria even with mitigation-unacceptable impact.  Responses still to come from Historic England, Natural England, Anglian Water and SCC. So none of the assessments are completed yet.
