Fressingfield Parish Council Infrastructure Investment Plan 2023-Dec 2024

Review December 2023

This Village Improvement Plan (VIP) was first devised in May 2019. It sits alongside the Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) to promote the on-going improvements in the village.

The plan was previously reviewed by the parish council in July 2022. Areas for development were rag-rated as Red: Little headway and ongoing.

Yellow r: underway and on-going and Green: completed. The same process was carried out in December 2023. New projects have been added refinements to existing developments have been included and concluded projects noted.

The plan forms an active part of the parish council's programme of meetings and working groups. It is in no way definitive and will dynamically change and grow to allow chosen developments to take place. Inputs from residents are crucial at all levels. Some of the new projects have emerged from local people's ideas.

Each area under consideration has been identified but within each more work, detailing objectives, costs, benefits and those engaged in the improvements will need to be carried out. Some of the projects have a working group comprising councillors and residents. Others require a strategic overview from the council where residents lead on projects.

As a plan it can be expected to develop to meet new visions. Funding streams will be an important aspect and parish councillors will keep careful prudent track of any funding commitments made.
